

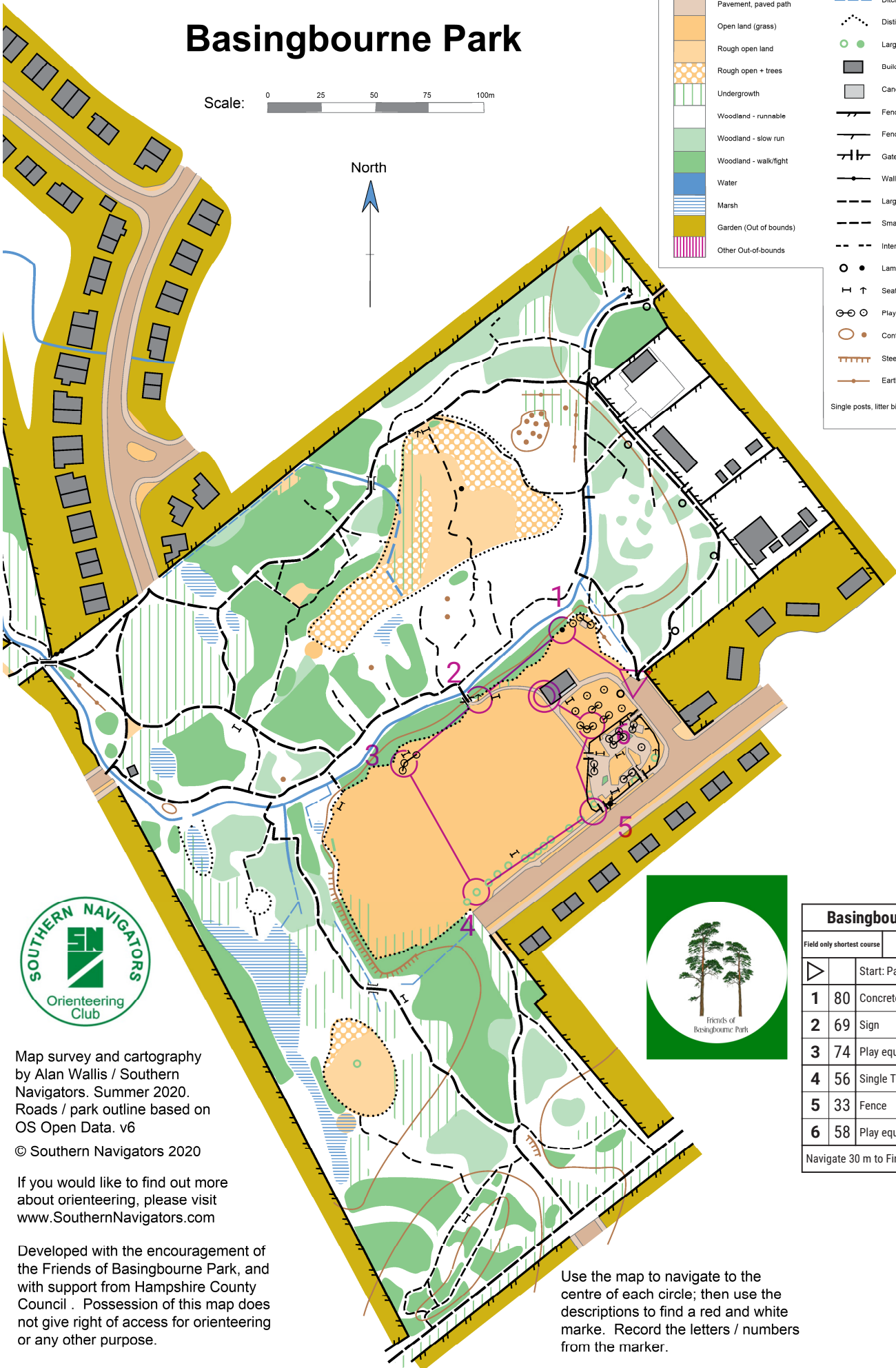
# Basingbourne Park

Field only shortest course	<b>0.4 km</b>
	Start: Path, SE. End
<b>1</b>	80 Concrete drain/block
<b>2</b>	69 Sign
<b>3</b>	74 Play equipment
<b>4</b>	56 Single Tree
<b>5</b>	33 Fence
<b>6</b>	58 Play equipment
Navigate 30 m to Finish
